

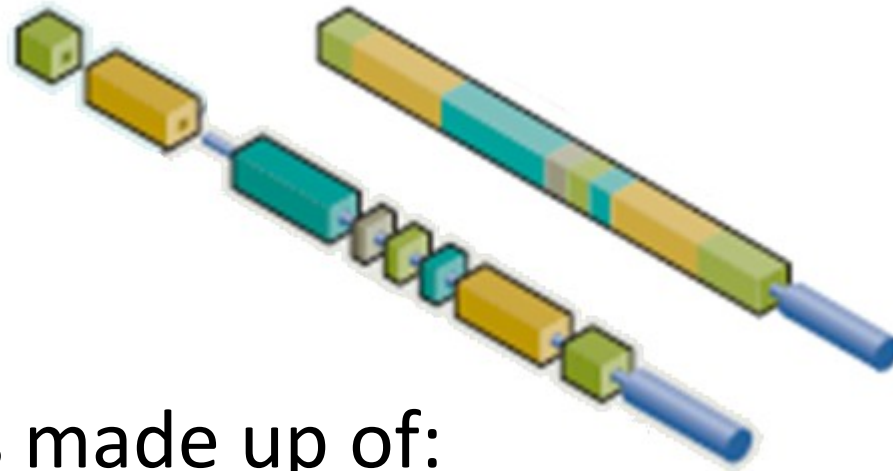

 - Know how the standard submission interface works
 - Have submitted an item into a DSpace repository

What is an item?



- An item is made up of:
 - Metadata
 - Bundles (e.g. ORIGINAL / LICENCE / TEXT)
 - Bitstreams

- A typical submission:
 - Choose a collection to submit to
 - Answer some initial questions
 - Enter some metadata
 - Upload some files
 - Verify the submission
 - Agree to the deposit licence

- Submit an item to your repository
 - Enter a collection you have created
 - Perform a submission using a test item supplied to you
